## About Elephant Lab

We encourage experimentation and collaboration, bringing artists together with scientists to investigate the correlation between life and art.

- The bursary is for studio space only and does not cover any living costs.
- You must agree to produce 1 blog for the New Contemporaries website.

## **Application Requirements:**

To apply please submit one PDF document set in 11 point font containing the information below, presented in the following order:

- 1. Artist CV containing contact details. No more than 1 page of A4.
- 2. Short statement of no more than 300 words about your work.
- 3. Summary of no more than 300 words explaining how the opportunity will benefit your practice.
- 4. Short proposal of no more than 300 words describing how you plan to use the studio. For artists applying that are not currently based in London, it would be useful to understand how you are going to support yourself, as living expenses are not included in the bursary. All proposals should have one or more of the following attributes:
  - Experimental
  - Innovative
  - Collaborative
- 5. Which year you exhibited in Bloomberg New Contemporaries (2016 2020)
- 6. A maximum of 5 images of your work or Vimeo links. Including title, year of completion and medium of work. Please note that these works must have been completed within the last 2 years.
